## Lecture/Teacher Directions

- Teacher is giving directions or giving information to the class.
  - Actively listen to teacher
  - Raise hand and wait to be called on
  - Resist side conversations
  - Complete work

## Class Discussion

- Teacher and class are reviewing material or engaged in discussion together
  - Actively listen to teacher and other students
  - Make your positive contribution to the activity
  - Raise hand and wait to be called on
  - Actively participate in review or discussion
  - Resist side conversations
  - Complete work

## Silent Singles

- Students are engaged in silent work by themselves. Teacher checks on individual student progress and assists when needed.
  - Raise hand and wait to be called on
  - Resist side conversations
  - Actively complete work
  - Use class time effectively
  - Stay on task
  - Stay in seat
  - Ask questions if you need help!

## Study Buddies

- Students work with a partner. Teacher checks on group progress, assists, and challenges students in learning process.
  - Only one other partner, not large groups
  - Stay in with your group
  - Conversations within group, not conversations across groups
  - Actively complete work
  - Use class time effectively
  - Stay on task
  - Ask questions if you need help!
  - Raise hand and wait to be called on

- Two Study Buddy groups get together to complete an activity or exchange information.
  - Conversations within group, not conversations across groups
  - Actively complete work
  - Use class time effectively
  - Stay on task
  - Stay with your group
  - Ask questions if you need help!
